Worship

 - Lead the church in Sung worship on Sundays and equipping others to do likewise, creating an environment that is marked by the presence and power of God the Holy Spirit.
 - Plan the worship and production (sound and visual) rotas.
 - Oversee and develop the worship and music production teams in presenting songs that help congregants to worship God in ways that reflect their cultural, ethnic spirituality and religious expressions.
